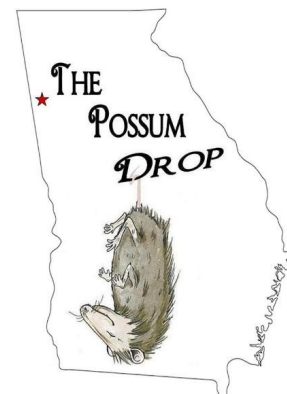

About The Possum Drop New Year's Eve Celebration: We Do Not Use a Live Opossum, It Is Stuffed.

The celebration which began in the mid 1990's with a small gathering of friends and local residents has now grown to crowds of 7000 to 10,000 people. Visitors travel to this West Ga town from across the nation to celebrate on New Year's Eve and watch a Stuffed Possum named "Spencer" be lowered from the top of one of the city's oldest buildings at midnight to ring in the New Year.

Before taking the name of the nearby river, Tallapoosa was originally named "Possum Snout" in the 1800's. To solidify the unofficial possum mascot, **Bud Jones, a local taxidermist, decided to stuff and preserve a possum he found dead on the side of the road in the mid-1990s. He named it "Spencer," after 19th century Tallapoosa businessman Ralph Spencer.**

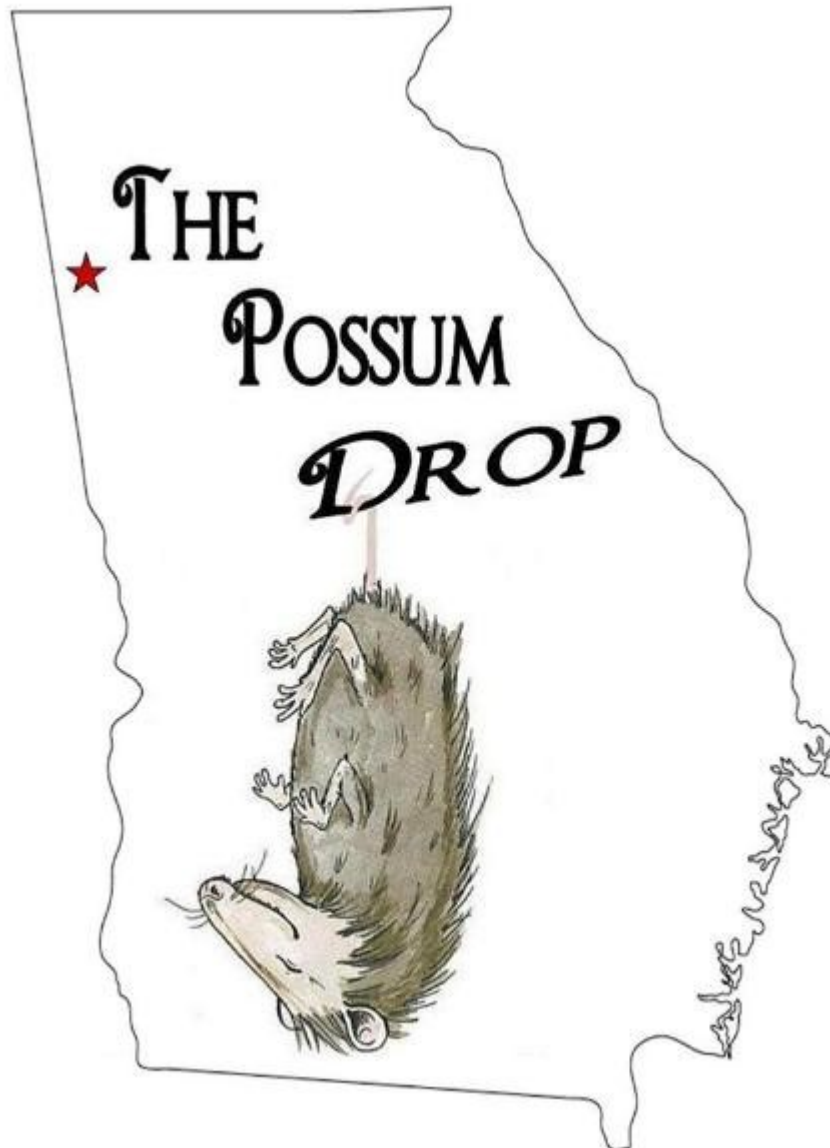
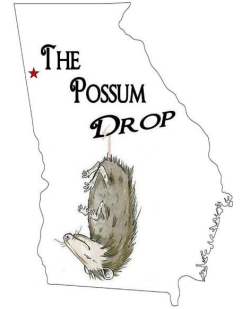

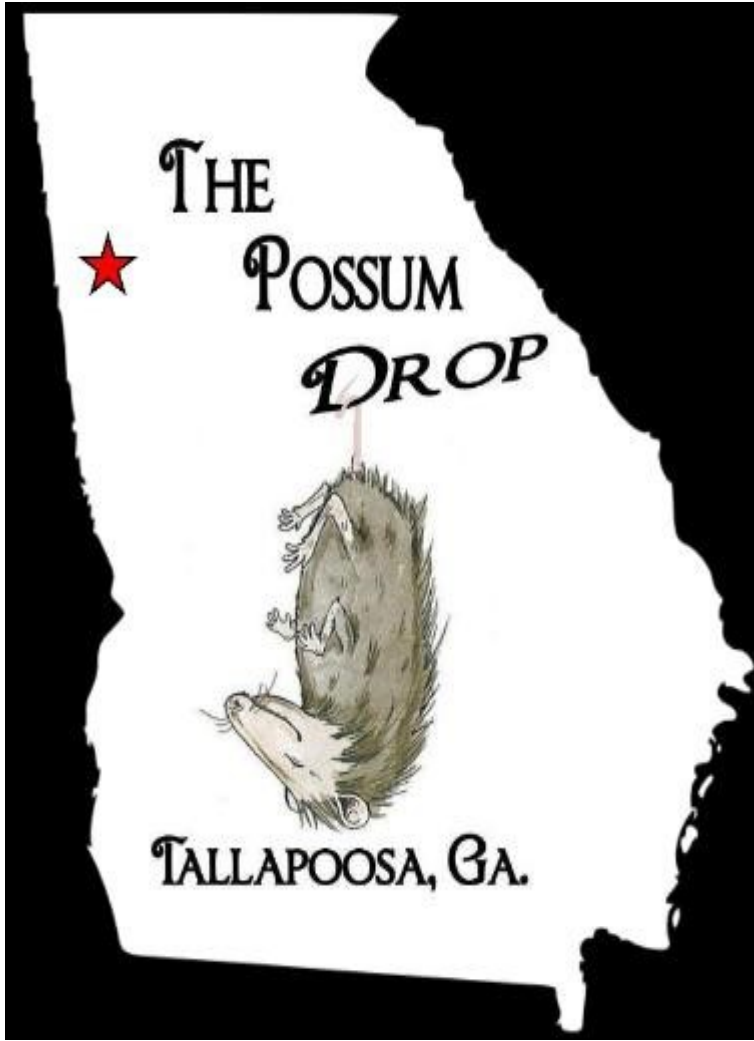
